PARKING at CENTRAL

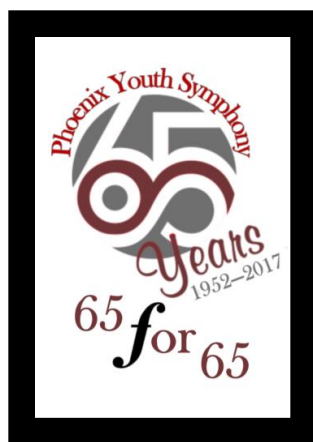
